at the 2010 PAPTAC Annual Meeting

This is a call for abstracts of seminars and posters for presentation in sessions sponsored by PAPIER during the PAPTAC 96th Annual Meeting. This meeting will take place at the Fairmont Queen Elizabeth Hotel in Montreal, February 2-4, 2010. The posters will be displayed during the meeting on Feb. 3 (Wednesday), and the seminars will take place in a separate event the following day, Feb. 4 (Thursday).

Abstracts should be in MS Word format and should provide a brief summary of no more than 500 words of the objectives, methods of research, and results. Please include the presenter's name and affiliation (including department), and name(s) of supervisor(s) along with your email address. In an effort to preserve the high standards of the seminars, it is important to have presentations on work-in-progress or near completion as opposed to research plans.

Abstracts should be e-mailed to kerekes@chbe.ubc.ca. In your email, please specify whether your submission is for a seminar or poster. The deadline for receipt of abstracts is **October 16th, 2009**.

The top three seminars will receive a Henry Bolker Award, and the top three poster presentations will receive an Alkis Karnis Memorial Prize.

On the evening of the seminars (Feb4), there will be banquet for students and professors. Further details on this event will be available soon.

Please note that no subsidies will be available from PAPIER for student travel expenses. Please note further that all individuals presenting or attending these PAPIER events must register for the PAPTAC Meeting.
